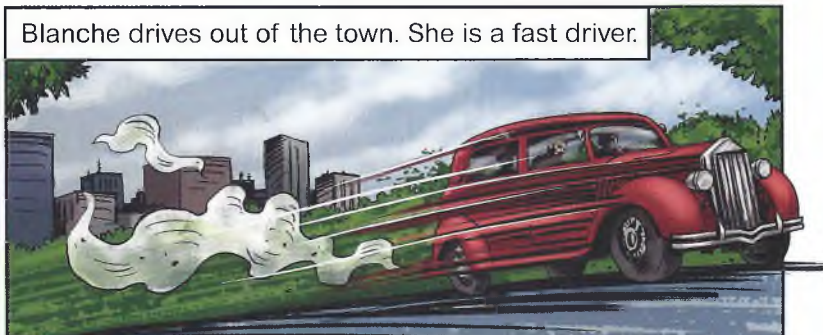

Suddenly, Blanche sees a car.

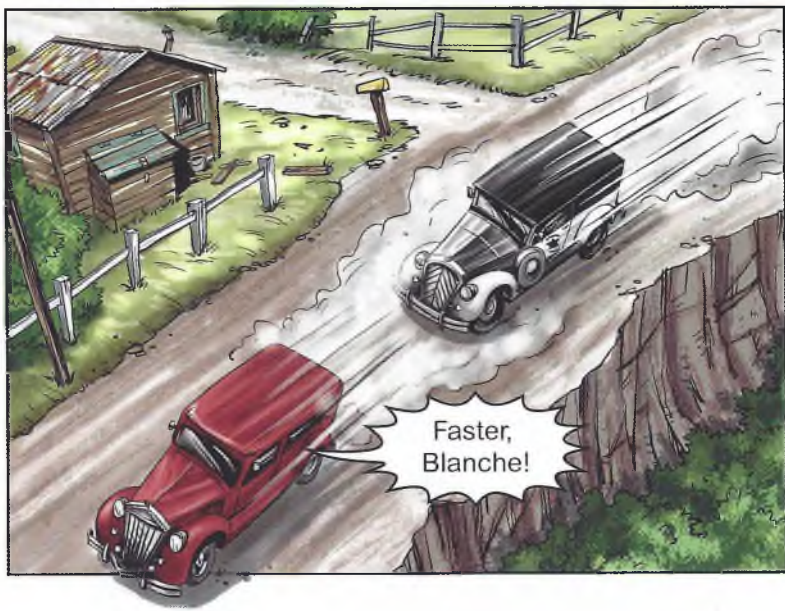
The police!

Blanche!



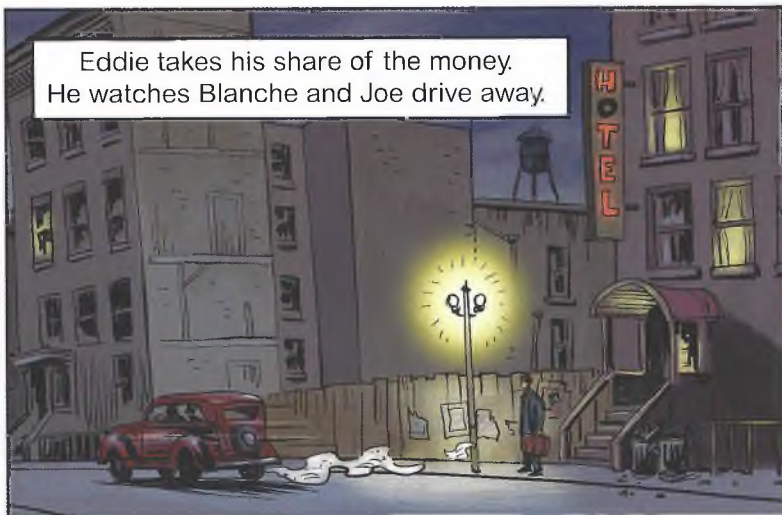
Blanche drives the car faster, but it is dangerous.

you staying?

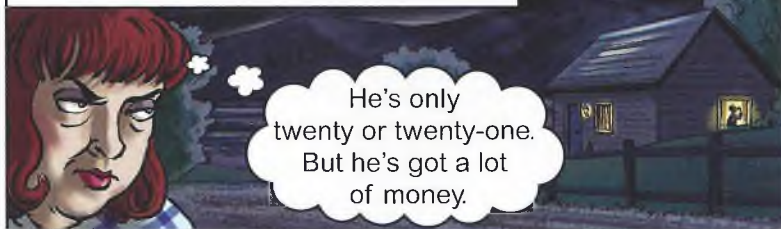
Hi.

walk by the lake.

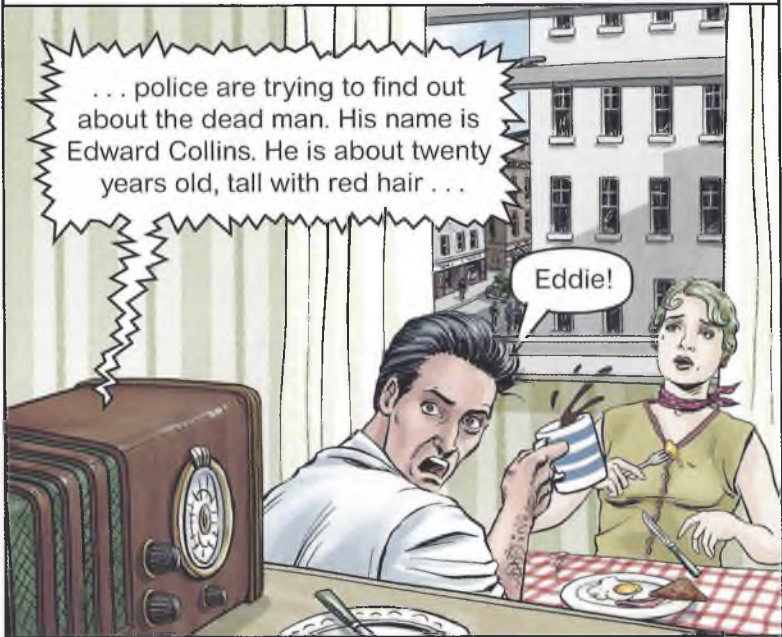
Has Dexter

The money!



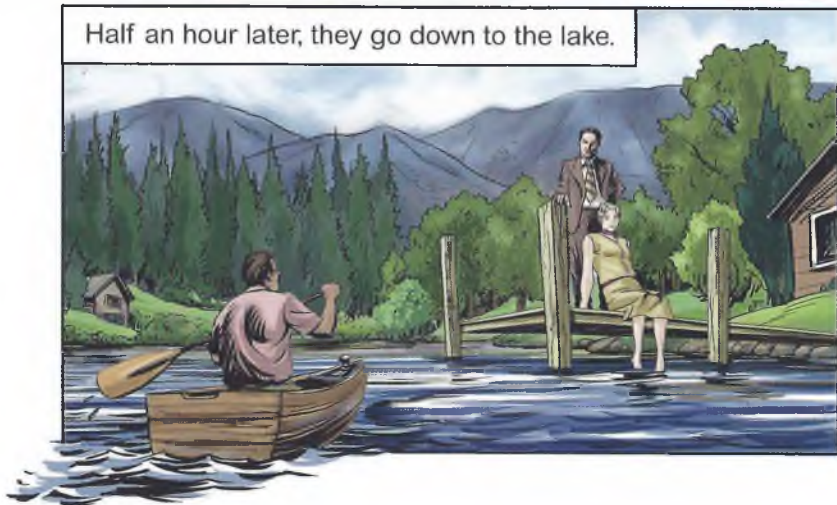
Mr Dexter is going to look for the money when he gets back. I can take it later. But what do I do about Mr Dexter?

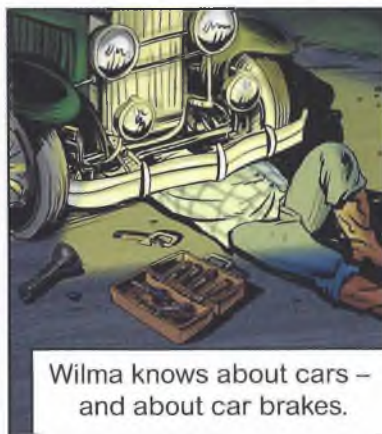
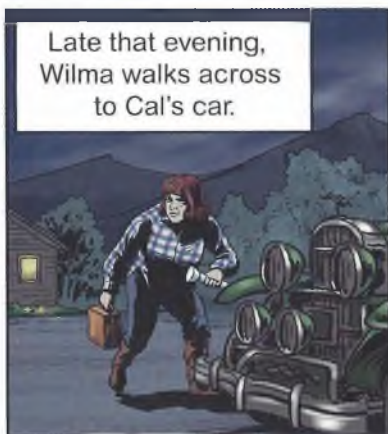
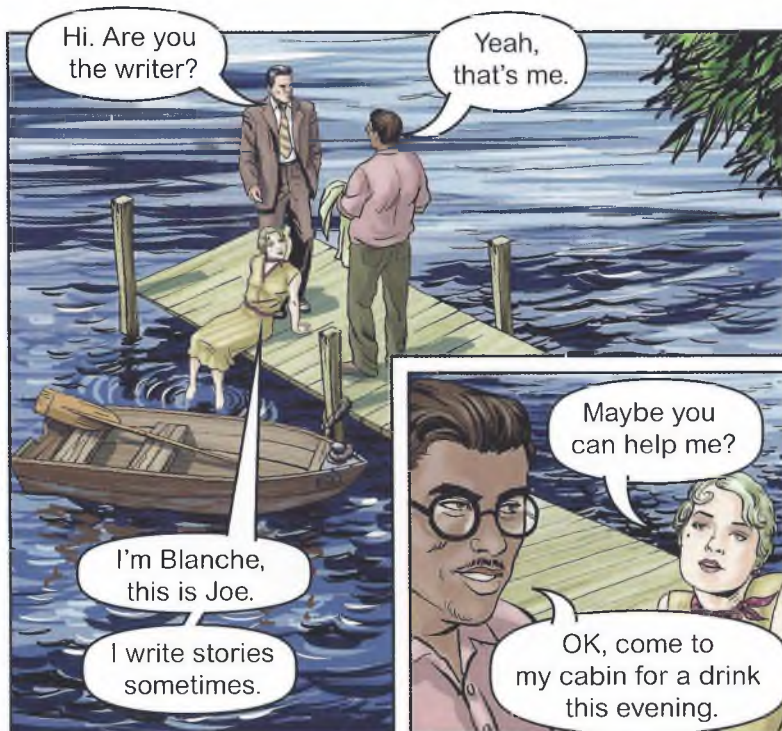




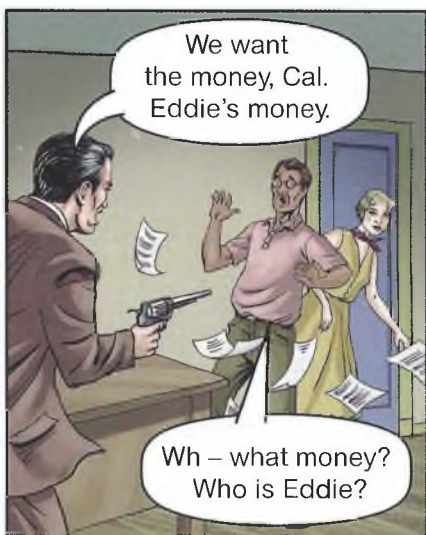


Half an hour later, they go down to the lake.

Dead Man's Money

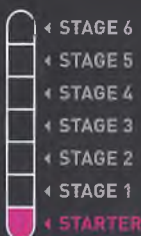
